

- 1. The Members of the Council and the Guests will be seated in the Town Hall, Middlesbrough prior to 11.30am.
- 2. The Chair of Middlesbrough Council (Councillor Stephen Bloundele) will take his seat.
- 3. The Chair will call upon the Chief Executive to read the Resolution.
- 4. The Chair will call upon The Elected Mayor, Ray Mallon to propose and Councillor John McPartland to second a Resolution to admit Mr Jack Hatfield to the Honorary Freedom of the Borough
- After the Resolution has been proposed and seconded the Chair will call upon the Mayor and other Members of the Council to speak to the Resolution.

6. The Chair will put the Resolution to the Meeting, and after the same has been declared carried, the Chief Executive will read the Oath of Freedom as follows:

"Will you, Jack Hatfield, swear to be true to our Sovereign Lady Queen Elizabeth II, Her Heirs and Successors, as a free and franchised person of this Borough?

Will you preserve the peace and tranquillity of the said Borough, and will you disclose to the Chair for the time being, details of any unlawful meetings or assemblies which come to your attention?

Will you do all in your power to contribute to the good government and safety of the said Borough and the inhabitants thereof?

Will you also defend the customs and privileges of the Borough in every just and lawful cause?

So help you God"

7. Jack Hatfield will signify acceptance of the Oath, by replying "I WILL".

The Chair will then invite Mr Jack Hatfield to sign the Roll of Admissions of Freedom and invite the signature to be witnessed by the Chair and the Chief Executive.

- After the signing of the Roll, the Chair will present a sealed and illuminated framed copy of the resolution inscribed on vellum, and will offer congratulations on behalf of the Council and the people of the Borough.
- 9. Flowers will be presented to Mrs Hatfield.
- 10. Mr Jack Hatfield will reply.
- 11. The Director of Legal and Democratic Services will report receipt of any communications.
- 12. At the conclusion of the formal proceedings, the Chair will leave the Council Chamber accompanied by all those present holding the Freedom of the Borough.
- 13. An Invitation is extended to the Members of the Council and all Guests to then adjourn to the Council Suite for refreshments.
