Additional Funding from the Department for Transport 2014/15

Following the prolonged period of severe winter weather earlier this year, which caused extensive damage to the local highway network, the Department for Transport provided Middlesbrough Council with an emergency funding allocation of £140,000 to assist with highway repairs and improvements. The following is a statement of how the funding is proposed to be spent:

A proportion of the funding (£80,000) has been allocated to preventive maintenance treatment on the road network. This will involve resurfacing a number of carriageways where the surface course has deteriorated as a result of standing water.

The remainder of the funding (£60,000) will be used in carrying out localised patch repairs on roads that are showing early signs of becoming structurally defective, drainage repairs, placing new gullies and channels and finally carriageway joint sealing to prevent the ingress of surface water.
