## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (SOUTHWELL ROAD) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary prohibition of driving on Southwell Road from its junction with the northern kerb line of Eastbourne Road for a distance of approx. 28 metres in a northerly direction because of traffic signal improvement works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being Mulgrave Road and Rochester Road.

The road will be closed from 03/01/2023 for up to 18 months. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road.
