RE: LINTHORPE ROAD WALKING AND CYCLING INFRASTRUCTURE FINAL DESIGN

Following previous correspondence, the Council has considered comments received from stakeholders, and has been able to adapt the original plans to accommodate some of the suggestions put forward to improve the scheme for all.

Summary of changes

- Alterations to the design to reduce the angle of the running cycleway at key junctions and crossing points.
- Buffer provision between carriageway and cycleway (at parking locations) incorporated.
- Two additional informal pedestrian crossing points accommodated.
- Creation of five marked disabled spaces on side streets.
- Alterations to the junction of Granville Road to minimise vehicle speeds and improve safety for all.
- Two retained Taxi ranks (between 6PM and 8AM) either side of Southfield Road junction.
- Nine additional car parking spaces have been accommodated on Linthorpe Road
- Five car parking spaces will be created on Woodlands Road.
- Proposed housing plans on Amber Street car park have been re-negotiated, the car park will remain operational (86 spaces saved).
- Improvements to the appearance and safety of Amber Street Car Park will be undertaken.
- Re-introduced bus stops North of Ayresome Road junction
- On-going investigation in to additional car parking space allocation/access in the area.
- Surrounding residential streets have the capability to accommodate up to 45 minute parking allocations without displaying a ticket/permit.
- No changes to designated loading spaces
- In the balance of available space, customer parking provision has been favoured over loading. No additional designated loading facilities are to be created, however, the Traffic Regulation Orders in place will permit loading from car parking spaces
- Increased Civil Enforcement Officer patrols of the area to ensure people are not over-utilising the space, to improve efficiency and turnover
