## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (BUXTON STREET CAR PARK) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2023

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers to assist works on the highway.

A section of Buxton Street car park will be closed on 07/08/2023 for up to 18 months. The section of Buxton Street car park from the eastern end of the car park from a point of approx. 79 metres east from the eastern kerbline with Albert Mews for the remainder of the car park in an easterly direction will be closed to motorists to allow office facilities to operate whilst works are carried out on the highway. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The temporary closure of a section of the car park will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the car park and part of the car park will still be open for use. Access will be maintained for the emergency services where possible.
