Minutes of Extraordinary General Meeting

1.0 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Consideration of new planning applications.

[M/FP/0402/14/P](#) 143 Guisborough Road 14.04.14. Single storey extension at rear – Full plans. End of consultation due date 06.05.2014.

Cllr. Yates proposed that no objection is necessary as the previous plans approved for this property were for a large extension and the new application is for half of the original size. Cllr Webb seconded this and all members were in agreement.

Resolution: No objection.

[M/FP/0399/14/P](#) 2 Westwood Avenue, 11.04.14 – First Floor extension over garage and single storey extensions (demolition of old extension) – Full plans. End of consultation due date 05.05.2014.

Cllr. Webb proposed that due to the large property and curtilage there was no requirements to object. Seconded by Cllr. Yates and agreed by all members.

Resolution: No objection.

2.0 EAST MIDDLESBROUGH TRANSPORT CORRIDOR (EMTC).

Cllr. Yates advised that local agencies all mention connectivity being key for the area. He felt this is correct and that forward planning needs serious consideration for transport in the area. Councillors voiced their disappointment that the Marton West Ward Councillors had not been involved in this project and all were in agreement that the EMTC needs building and agreed that a letter be sent to the Mayor and the Chief Executive of Middlesbrough Council, and the Highways Dept. Cllr Harrison suggested an addition to the letter that the Parish Council understands that the Highways Dept. are looking at other alternatives and ask to be advised of the alternatives. Cllrs. discussed changes to political references and Cllr. Yates proposed that following the changes being made that the letter produced by the Advisory Committee be sent. Seconded by Cllr. Harrison and agreed by all.
