What you'll be doing

You'll be helping area care and parks staff with street cleaning and horticultural duties, and helping refuse operatives to deliver essential front-line council services.

Your duties will include:

- litter picking, street cleaning, grass cutting, shrub bed maintenance, sports pitch marking
- refuse collections, alley cleaning, bulky waste collections

At the end of your placement you'll have:

- personal skills - communication, team working, problem solving, personal development
- operational skills - basic gardening tasks, safe use of hand tools and light plant / machinery
