What you'll be doing

During the placement you'll be carrying out all cleaning and associated duties in relation to the operation of the cleaning service.

Your duties will include:

- sweeping, vacuum cleaning, disposing of rubbish, dust damp wiping, burnishing, mopping, cleaning of toilet / shower areas, and other associated activities
- working in accordance with the work schedule and customer requirements
- following all council and site rules, regulations, procedures, and policies
- using cleaning machinery, equipment, and chemicals in accordance with Middlesbrough Council's COSHH procedures
- reporting any unsafe procedures, working practices, and unsafe machinery, including any dangerous occurrences, near misses, and accidents, to your line supervisor immediately

By the end of the placement you'll have:

- experience and knowledge of all aspects of the cleaning service
- an awareness of the importance of health and safety
- experience of waste management
