

50 Futures Work Experience Role Description – Scaffolder Support at Peter Conway Scaffolding

Middlesbrough Council work placements, and those of our partners have been developed to support residents from a range of backgrounds and levels of ability.

Role: Scaffolder Support

Purpose of Post: To assist with erecting and dismantling temporary metal scaffolding on structures and building sites.

General Duties:

- Unload scaffolding from a lorry
- Create a stable base on the ground
- Put up scaffolding poles and attach horizontal tubes to them
- Fix scaffolding to a building
- Lay planks across scaffolding for workers to walk on
- Fix guard rails and safety nets
- Check the scaffold is secure before handing over
- Take down scaffolding at the end of a job

Experience and Skills you will gain:

- Knowledge of building and construction
- To be thorough and pay attention to detail
- Patience and the ability to remain calm in stressful situations
- The ability to work well with others
- The ability to work well with your hands
- Knowledge of public safety and security
- The ability to operate and control equipment
- Physical fitness and endurance
- To be able to carry out basic tasks on a computer or hand-held device

Prerequisites:

- You will need a Construction Industry Record Scheme (CISRS) safety card or equivalent to train and work on a construction site.
