ALBERT ROAD
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2017**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 1st November 2017 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below because of building refurbishment works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The length of road affected will be the parking bays on the west side of Albert Road from a point 10 metres north of the junction of Bedford Street for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction. The bays will be closed from 6th November 2017 for 34 weeks or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
