

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
CHURCH LANE, JUNCTION WITH ACKLAM ROAD
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 22nd July 2019 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to due to major gas replacement works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed from 29th July and will approximately last for 3 weeks or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The length of road affected is Church Lane from the junction of Acklam Road for a distance of 33 meters in an easterly direction.

Traffic will be diverted via Church Lane, St Marys Walk, Green Lane and Acklam Road.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
