

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
(ELM STREET & GURNEY STREET CAR PARKS)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that Middlesbrough Council intends to make an order to temporarily prevent vehicles from using Elm Street car park set out below because of works taking place on or near the road to. Also to restrict the use of 25 parking bays within Gurney Street Car Park to use by GC permit holders only.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times.

Elm Street Car Park will be closed and 25 bays within Gurney Street Car Park will be restricted to use by GC permit holders from 2nd July 2018 for eighteen months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.

The car parks affected are;

Elm Street Car Park - An area of land bounded by Elm Street, the former Register Office site, a line parallel to and 7.2m west of Elm Street and a line parallel to and 7m south of Corporation Road.

Gurney Street Car Park – An area bounded by Wilson Street, the Premier Inn Hotel Car Park, the Jury's Inn Hotel and Gurney House.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
