FAIRFIELD ROAD AREA  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2018 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below because of the reconstruction of highway taking place on or near the road(s) because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road(s) will be closed as required from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> March for 70 weeks or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The lengths of roads affected are –

- Byrneside Avenue (full length).
- Fairfield Road from its junction with Marton Burn Road for a distance of 160m in an easterly direction.
- Crofton Avenue (full length).
- Hawthorne Avenue (full length).

Traffic will be diverted via Marton Burn Road and Bishopton Road.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
