- (3) Before or immediately following the removal of any hoarding, scaffolding, fencing, platforms, handrail, etc, the licensee shall level and make safe the surface of the public highway, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Council against all liability, claims and demands whatsoever in the event of any accident, occurrence, subsidence or sinking of the surface of the public way, or the execution or non-execution of any work, or anything whatsoever arising thereat. All hoards, scaffolds, fencing, platforms, handrails, etc, be erected and maintained to the satisfaction of the Engineer and his approval endorsed upon the licence.
