TURNOUT: No meaningful data as this is a new station replacing 2 existing ones.
STREETS INCLUDED (See attached map): Acklam Road, Blue Bell Grove, Canton Gardens, Cherrywood Court, Evenwood Gardens, Finchlay Court, Harbourne Gardens, Hazelwood Court, Hemlington Lane, Hillel Walk, Ladgate Lane, Low Lane, Malvern Drive, Medbourne Gardens, Medina Gardens, Otterburn Gardens, Romanby Gardens, Rowanwood Court, Samaria Gardens, Sambrook Gardens, Sandalwood Court, Sandy Flatts Court, Shoreswood Walk, Tanya Gardens, Thinford Gardens, Virginia Gardens.

ELECTORAL OFFICERS COMMENTS:	
Location & suitability	New station replacing existing mobile units at Sandy Flatts Lane and Thinford Gardens. Centrally located to replace both previous stations, with access from a nearby pedestrian crossing for those properties on the east side of Acklam Road. The previous 2 mobile stations were both very small serving 277 and 762 electors, so the combined total is still well within the capacity of one mobile station.

Access	Fully accessible
Facilities for staff	Poor
Recommendation	No suitable buildings located within polling district.

RETURNING OFFICERS COMMENTS:
I support the relocating of this station and the amalgamation with the previous station at Sandy Flatts Lane, which served an extremely small number of electors. Mobile stations are expensive to operate, costing approximately 3 times the cost of a station within a public building and facilities for station staff are poor. Unfortunately there is no suitable public building in this polling district, and local business premises are unwilling to allow their premises to be used, so a mobile in this location is the only practical option.
