

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (LINTHORPE ROAD)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being Linthorpe Road between its junctions with Borough Road and Ayresome Street, together with all side roads off Linthorpe Road over this length for a distance of up to 60m from Linthorpe Road for each side road. The temporary closures will include any on-street parking bays, waiting restrictions, loading, permit holders, disabled parking bays, bus stops and taxi ranks as required, because of highway improvement works. Alternative highways will be available for use while the Order is in force.

The road(s) are programmed to be closed (as required) from 14/03/2022 for up to 16 weeks. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The temporary closures will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
