

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH  
(MARTON WEST BECK FOOTPATHS)  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents pedestrians from using the length(s) of footpath set out below because of works taking place on or near the footpath.

The footpath will be closed from 14<sup>th</sup> June 2018 for six months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.

The length of footpath affected commences from a point on the Footpath (Middlesbrough No.31) (Point A) and proceeds in a generally southerly and then easterly direction for approximately 331 metres to a set of steps on the Footpath (Point B). A total distance of approximately 331 metres and is shown as a solid black line on the order plan.

An alternative route is available from a point on the Footpath 'Middlesbrough No. 31' (Point A) and proceeds up a set of steps to a point on the footpath (Point C) then in a southerly then easterly direction for approximately 322 metres to a point on the footpath(Point D). Then in a south westerly direction for approximately 74 metres to a set of steps on a Footpath (Point B). A total distance of approximately 396 metres and is shown as a dashed black line on the order plan.

If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
