Help create a new meadowland when you die



Burial in a meadowland grave is one way of helping to create a new area full of native meadow plants and encourage wildlife.

It gives people a way of expressing concern about the environment and enables them to give something back to nature when they die. Middlesbrough Council recognises this need and has established a meadowland site in Acklam Cemetery.

The site is bounded by mature trees and hedging at the eastern end of the Cemetery near to the Woodland Burial area and is next to a cemetery roadway.

Meadowland graves are sold for either one interment or a double space

To ensure that loved ones are buried next to each other in a natural setting you will need to purchase two plots.

When the ground has settled after burial native wildflower seeds will be strewn on top. The area will be managed as traditional meadowland.

Each plot will be identified by the use of underground and maintenance free electronic marker pegs that will be vandal and weatherproof.

Grave plots can be purchased at any time and the exclusive right of burial is granted for 100 years commencing from the day of purchase.

Cost – exclusive right of burial for 100 years is £765.00 single, £1030.00 double (1st April 2015)

To allow the meadowland area to develop with minimal disturbance we will encourage people not to walk on the grave plots. No personal items or other memorials should be placed on the grave.

APPLICATION TO PURCHASE A MEADOWLAND GRAVE

Please read this form carefully and ask the funeral director or cemetery staff to explain anything that you do not understand. You are recommended to visit the Cemetery and see the Meadowland plot before you sign this form.
