**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2018 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the lengths of road set out below due to electricity cable works by Northern Powergrid taking place on or near the roads because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers. The roads will be closed as detailed below or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.
