(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2017

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (“the Council”) in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 S.I. 1996 No 2489 (“the Regulations”) and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 32, 32(1), 35, 35(1), 45, 46, 46A, 47, 49, 51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (“the Act”) have made an Order, the effect of which is to revoke the provisions of The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (Off street parking places) (Consolidation) Order 2015 (as amended) and re-enact those provisions without any change of substance by implementing The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough (Off street parking places) (Consolidation) Order 2017.

It is anticipated that the Order will come into force on date 23rd October 2017. Full details and descriptions are contained in the Order, which may be examined during normal office hours at the Reception of the Town Hall Middlesbrough for six weeks from the date specified below.
