ELM STREET
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2018**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 28th May 2018 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to the need to facilitate the safe construction of an office development on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road is scheduled to be closed from early June 2018 for up to 18 months, or until the works been completed, whichever is the sooner. The length of road affected is Elm Street from a point 26m south of the southern kerb line of Corporation Road for a distance of 52m in a southerly direction.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
