

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
A66 NEWPORT INTERCHANGE SLIP ROADS
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 28th October 2019 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the lengths of roads set out below due to electricity cable works by Northern Powergrid taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The roads will be closed from 19:00hrs until 06:00hrs on the programmed dates of 4th, 5th & 14th November 2019 or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public. The lengths of road affected are the A66 eastbound exit slip road and westbound entry slip road at the Newport Interchange. Traffic will be diverted via the A66 eastbound carriageway, Hartington Interchange and the A66 westbound carriageway.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
