

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
(ALBERT STREET / GOSFORD STREET)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary road closure of Albert Street from its junction with the southern kerb line of Gosford Street for a distance of approx. 55m in a southerly direction (programmed dates 27/08/20 – 17/09/20) and suspension of pay & display parking bays on Gosford Street along the northern side of the road from a point approx. 39m west of the western kerb line of Cleveland Street for a distance of approx. 44m in a westerly direction (programmed dates 31/08/20 – 08/09/20) because of redevelopment works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being Bridge Street West and Queens Square. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
