

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
BRASS CASTLE LANE
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 10th February 2020 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to the installation of a new water supply taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed from 17th February 2020 for five days or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The length of road affected is Brass Castle Lane from a point approximately 40m from its junction with the B1365 for a distance of approximately 380m in an easterly direction to the unnamed road on Brass Castle Lane.

An alternative route is available via B1365, Stainton Way, Dixons Bank, The Fairway, Turnberry Way and Fulford Way.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
