

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH  
BRIARDENE AVENUE  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that Middlesbrough Council intends to prevent vehicles from using the lengths of road set out below due to sewer repair works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed from 6th February till the 8<sup>th</sup> February 2019 or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The length of road affected is Briardene Avenue, outside No. 16. Traffic will be diverted via Branksome Avenue, Easby Avenue and Lynwood Avenue.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
