

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
CAVENDISH ROAD
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 19th May 2020 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to BT installation works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed from 26th May 2020 for up to three days or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public. The length of road affected is Cavendish Road (south) from its junction with the Marton Way roundabout for a distance of approx. 150m in a southerly direction. Traffic will be diverted via Newington Road, Pemberton Crescent, Hurworth Road and Cavendish Road.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
