

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (CHURCH CLOSE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary road closure of Church Close from a point approx. 37 metres north of the northern kerb line of Hemlington Road for a distance of 23 metres in a northerly direction because of Northern Powergrid works.

The road will be closed from 19th October for up to two weeks. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
