

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (DEEPDALE AVENUE)  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it has made an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary road closure of Deepdale Avenue between its junctions with Keith Road and Woodville Avenue, because of road marking works. Alternative highway routes will be available for use while the Order is in force being Woodville Avenue, Laurel Avenue and Thorndyke Avenue.

The roads will be closed from 17<sup>th</sup> August 2020 for up to three days. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
