

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
DEEPDALE AVENUE
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 9th March 2020 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to NWL manhole inspection works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed from 16th March 2020 for two days or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public. The length of road affected is Deepdale Avenue from its northern kerb line with the junction of Fulwood Avenue to its southern kerb line with the junction of Thorndyke Avenue. Traffic will be diverted via Keith Road, Marton Burn Road, Marton Road, Cavendish Road and Grassington Road.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
