DENMARK STREET CAR PARK
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 30th April 2019 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the Denmark Street car park as set out below because of works taking place on the car park because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

The car park will be closed from Monday 13th May 2019 for 2 weeks or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The car park affected is Denmark Street car park, an area of land bounded by the Hartington Road interchange link, Newport Road, Wilson Street, the Sainsburys Supermarket and a line parallel to and 104m north of the northern kerbline of Newport Road.

Alternative long stay car parks are Captain Cook Square, Cannon Park, Station Street and Zetland.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
