

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH  
EXCHANGE PLACE  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary closure of the footpaths on Queen's Square in a southerly direction from the junctions of Bridge Street West and Bridge Street East restricting access to the underpass because of bridge inspection works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being Bridge St West, North Road, B1272 and Newport Road.

The road will be closed from 22/05/2022 for up to 5 days. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport. The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road.

2	Queens Square from a point of approx. 10m south of its junction with Bridge Street East for a distance of approx. 45m in a southerly direction
