KESTREL AVENUE  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 20<sup>th</sup> January 2020 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to sewer repair works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed from 27<sup>th</sup> January 2020 – 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020 or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public. The length of road affected is Kestrel Avenue from No. 20 to the end of the road with its junction of Merlin Road.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
