MARSHALL AVENUE  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2019 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to manhole replacement works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed on Sunday 1st of September 2019 between 8:00 – 13:00 hrs or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The length of road affected is Marshall Avenue from a point 80m from its junction with the eastern kerb line of Kedward Avenue for a distance of 30m in an easterly direction.

General traffic will be diverted via Ferndale Avenue, Pallister Avenue and Kedward Avenue. Buses will divert via Cargo Fleet Lane and College Road.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
