

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH
PELHAM STREET
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020**

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over an area of the highway being a temporary road closure at Pelham Street from a point 20 metres north of its junction with Princes Road for a distance of approx. 10 metres in a northerly direction on Pelham Street because of Northumbrian Water works. An alternative highway will be available for use while the Order is in force being Princes Road, Portman Street and Garnet Street.

The road will be closed from 30th September 2020 for 1 day. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The temporary closure will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.
