SIMPSON STREET  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles from using the length of road set out below due to NWL connection works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The road will be closed all day on Sunday 10th November 2019 or until the works have been completed and there is no longer a danger to the public.

The length of road affected is Simpson Street from its junction with Linthorpe Road for a distance of 20m in an easterly direction.

Traffic will be diverted via Stonehouse Street.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
