

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH  
GOSFORD STREET / SUSSEX STREET  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 30<sup>th</sup> December 2019 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles and pedestrians from using the length of road set out below because of works taking place on or near the road.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The parking bays on the following lengths of road will be closed from 6th January 2020 – 5th April 2021 or until the works have been completed.

Gosford Street (North side)

From a point 98.2m west of the Western kerb line of Queens Square to a point 151.4m west of that kerb line.

Sussex Street – North section (East side)

From a point 10.6m south of the Southern kerb line of Gosford St to a point 28.3m south of that kerb line.

Sussex Street – North section (East side)

From a point 42.6m south of the Southern kerb line of Gosford St to a point 60.4m south of that kerb line.

Sussex Street – North Section (East side)

From a point 74.9m south of the Southern Kerb line to a point 93.2m south of that kerb line.

If the works are not completed within 18 months the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
