

## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH (HOSPITALITY REOPENING – VARIOUS ROADS) TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2020

The Council of the Borough of Middlesbrough gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and any other enabling powers over areas of the highway as detailed below because of hospitality reopening. Alternative highway routes available for use while the Order is in force will be signed locally. The roads will be closed as appropriate from 6<sup>th</sup> July 2020 for up to 18 months. The Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.

The temporary closures will not at any time prevent access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the road. Access will be maintained for the emergency services.

### **SCHEDULE: Prohibition of Driving**

<b>Road Affected</b>	<b>Description</b>
Zetland Road	One way eastbound only between its junctions with Brunswick Street and Albert Road.
Bolckow Street	On street parking / loading bays on its northern side from a point 23m west of its junction with the western kerb line of Linthorpe Road for a distance of 22m in a westerly direction.
Newport Crescent	On street disabled parking bays on its eastern side between its junctions with Newport Road and Park Street.
Park Street	On street pay & display parking bays on its southern side from its junction with the western kerb line of Newport Crescent for a distance of 42m in a westerly direction.
Albert Road	On street parking / loading bays on its western side from a point 7m south of its junction with the southern kerb line of Baker Street for a distance of 10m in a southerly direction.
King Edwards Road	Between its junctions with Linthorpe Road and Albert Road.
Southfield Road	Between its junctions with Linthorpe Road and Wilton Street.
