

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MIDDLESBROUGH  
VULCAN STREET  
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2017**

NOTICE is hereby given that on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2017 Middlesbrough Council made an Order which prevents vehicles set out below because of works taking place on or near the road because of the likelihood of danger to the public.

Access for pedestrians and the emergency services will be maintained at all times. Access will also be provided for vehicles used in connection with: maintenance and works carried out by statutory undertakers.

The lengths of road affected will be the parking bays on Vulcan Street as detailed below. The parking bays are to be suspended for up to 18 months with the intention of the parking bays to be permanently revoked within this time.

Vulcan Street (south west side) –

- From a point 68.5 meters south–east of the eastern kerb line of the unnamed road between Vulcan Street and Commercial Street to a point 200.7 meters south–east of the eastern kerb line of the unnamed road.
- From a point 205.6 meters south–east of the eastern kerb line of the unnamed road between Vulcan Street and Commercial Street to a point 257.9 meters south–east of the eastern kerb line of the unnamed road between Vulcan Street and Commercial Street.

If the works are not completed within 18 months, the Order may be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State.
